TERRACOTTA RAKU WORKSHOP FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2021-22

Date: 17.12.2021 to 30.12.2021 and 05.01.2022 to 07.01.2022

Chamarajendra Government College of Visual Arts, Mysore was organised a workshop on Terracotta Raku in the Department of Sculpture from 17.12.2021 to 30.12.2021 [excluding Holidays] and continued from 05.01.2022 to 07.01.2022 by National Level Artist and CAVA Alumni Mr. Vijayakumar was invited as a resource person and conducted successful.

Guidance of the resource person the work was created by mixing udichira and paddy husk in the soil and kneading it well. (10 inches high) A kiln was constructed of bricks in the college premises and the artworks were placed in it and baked. (Approximately 15 hrs. for 1 am) The artefacts were taken out of the oven the next day. 100 Art works that turned red in color are known as terracotta. In continuation of the prepared terracotta artworks are coated with ball clay, glaze, and oxide colors and placed in an oven made of ceramic wool. Art works were welded with 950° heated by LPG gas flame. A week-long exhibition was arranged of the artworks produced by workshop.
