**Eligibility**

- The Fresh applicants should have secured 50% marks in the last annual Board/Class examination (Not applicable for students studying in 1<sup>st</sup> std).
- Annual income of the students' Parents/ Guardians from all sources should not exceed
  - ✓ Rs.1 Lakh for Pre Matric Scholarship.
  - ✓ Rs.2 Lakh for Post Matric Scholarship.
  - ✓ Rs.2.5 Lakh for Merit Cum Means Scholarship.
- Student should belong to Karnataka State.
- Students of Karnataka domicile studying in other states are also eligible to apply in Karnataka.
- The applicant should be pursuing studies in India in Government or recognized Private University/Institute/College/School.
- The course being pursued should be of Minimum one year duration.
